RE: Manitoba Health Cold Chain Protocol and Return Policy for Immunizing Agents and Biologics

Cold Chain Protocol:

Improper storage and handling of immunizing agents and biologics can lead to decreased effectiveness and may not provide Manitobans with the expected protection against diseases.

To assist Health Care Providers to prevent this from occurring Manitoba Health has released a *Cold Chain Protocol for Immunizing Agents and Biologics*.

The Protocol includes:

- Cold chain responsibilities
- Management and accountability
- Storage and handling procedures
- Equipment standards
- Management and reporting of cold chain failures
- · Worksheets and Resources

Return Policy:

Immunizing agents and biologics that were provided by Manitoba Health that are either expired or have been exposed to temperatures outside of 2-8°C and deemed unusable are to be returned to the provincial vaccine warehouse for potential cost recovery and proper disposal.
