Manitoba's 2015-16 Universal Seasonal Influenza Immunization Program

Manitoba Health, Healthy Living and Seniors (MHHLS) will continue to offer a Universal Seasonal Influenza Immunization Program for the 2015-16 season. All Manitobans over 6 months of age will be eligible to receive the seasonal influenza vaccine free-of-charge. Health care providers are encouraged to offer seasonal influenza vaccine to all Manitobans at every opportunity.

Manitoba will have two seasonal influenza vaccines available this year as part of the provincial universal program, including Quadrivalent Influenza Vaccine (QIV), an inactivated influenza vaccine protecting Manitobans against 4 strains of influenza (2 strains of influenza A and 2 strains of influenza B). MHHLS will also have FluMist® Quadrivalent, the live attenuated intranasal vaccine that can be offered to healthy children and adolescents 2 to 17 years of age.
