Updated TB Prescription Forms

Greetings!

Starting from August 25, 2015, all TB prescription forms will be modified to reflect a change in the pharmacy that will be filling TB prescriptions for First Nations clients living in northern/rural communities.

Please note that as of August 25th, TB Prescriptions for First Nations clients living in northern/rural communities should be sent to Muskehki pharmacy (instead of Grand Medicine pharmacy). Prescription Shop remains the pharmacy of choice for those clients who do not fall within the Muskehki pharmacy criteria.

Please discard any old hard copies of the templates and use the new updated prescription templates (as of August 2015) available on Manitoba Health, Healthy Living and Seniors (MHHLS) website:
