Vaccine Returns

 Summer Cleaning – please use this time to locate all expired vaccine in your refrigerator and arrange with the provincial vaccine warehouse to have them returned. All vaccines, including influenza vaccine, must be returned once expired or as soon as possible for proper disposal and potential cost recovery.
