Manitoba Pneumococcal Immunization Program RE: Updated Eligibility & New FAQ

Manitoba Health, Seniors and Active Living recently updated its eligibility criteria (https://www.gov.mb.ca/health/publichealth/cdc/vaccineeligibility.html) for the pneumococcal conjugate (Pneu-C-13) vaccine and the pneumococcal polysaccharide (Pneu-P-23) vaccine.
