

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: The Clean Environment Commission and Barnes Western, a division of William R. Barnes Co. Limited, applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Barnes Western, a division of William R. Barnes Co. Limited has submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with an operation for the production of resin coated sand located at 640 Main Street, Selkirk (Blocks 1 to 7, Plan 19),

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the Clean Environment Commission by any person who is or is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation,

AND WHEREAS the Clean Environment Commission considered the application on the 29th day of May, 1973,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The applicant shall ensure that downwind ground level concentrations of dustfall over a thirty day period shall not exceed 1.5 milligrams per square centimeter above natural background level at any point of impingement off the said property,
2. The applicant shall ensure that the average concentration of suspended particulate material over a 24 hour period does not exceed 120 micrograms per standard cubic meter of air calculated at 20 degrees Centigrade and 760 millimeters of mercury, at any point of impingement off the said property.
