

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENTS LIMITED, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Controlled Environments Limited, filed a proposal with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management in connection with the operation of:

- (a) an existing plant for the manufacture of scientific research equipment located at or near 661 Century Street; and
- (b) a proposed plant for the manufacture of scientific research equipment to be located at or near 1461 St. James Street;

both plants being located in the City of Winnipeg, either or both operations resulting in emissions to the air;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS

no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is, or who may be affected by an Order of the Commission setting limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS

the said Commission considered the said proposal on the 28th day of April, 1975;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that at any point of impingement off the site of the said operations the odour emanating from the said operations shall not be detectable:


1. Cont'd . . .

- (a) in any area zoned residential, when one volume of odourous air is diluted with one volume of odour-free air; or
 - (b) in any area zoned industrial, when one volume of odourous air is diluted with six volumes of odour-free air;
2. The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emissions from any stack or vent of the said plants shall not exceed 0.57 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 20^o Celsuis and 760 millimeters of mercury (0.25 grains per standard cubic foot calculated at 68^o Fahrenheit and 30 inches of mercury) at the point of emission.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of maintenance and housekeeping are maintained consistent with meeting the limits prescribed in this Order.
