OVERVIEW:

On September 17, 2014, the Department received a Proposal from Exner E-Waste Processing Inc. which was determined to be incomplete. In October 2014 another Proposal was received that was accepted as complete on October 6, 2014. The Proposal was for the relocation and operation of an e-waste processing facility at 11 Woodstalk Way, near Elie, Manitoba.

On October 10, 2014 the Department placed an electronic copy of the Proposal in the Online Public Registry, and provided notice of the Proposal to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) members. The Department placed a public notification of the Proposal in the Winnipeg Free Press on October 11, 2014. The newspaper and TAC notification invited responses until October 24, 2014.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

No comments were received from the public.

COMMENTS FROM THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

No concerns were received regarding the proposal from TAC members that received the circulated proposal.

Manitoba Conservation, (Environmental Approvals Branch).

Clarification was sought from the proponent regarding:

- 1) Handling, storage and disposal of the dust collected from cyclone separators and filters.
- 2) Radiation detection on incoming materials.
- 3) Handling of PCB containing materials.
- 4) Handling of batteries, mercury tubes, leaded glass, phosphor powder and ethylene glycol and
- 5) Handling of Freon containing devices.

Disposition.

Where appropriate the answers will be incorporated into the draft Licence.

Manitoba Conservation (Environmental Compliance and Enforcement)

No concerns.

Manitoba Conservation (Environmental Programs and Strategies, Air Quality)

Concurs that no significant impact on air quality should occur provided that processes are managed as provided in the proposal, and that noise nuisance clause be included in Licence.
