SEVEN SISTERS GENERATING STATION – SHORT TERM EXTENSION LICENCE

We request renewal of the Short Term Extension Licence (STEL) for the Seven Sisters Generating Station under the provisions of Section 92(6) of Water Power Regulation 25/88R. We request that the STEL be renewed for an additional five year term. The Second STEL was issued for a five year term on August 26, 2015.

Manitoba Hydro submitted the technical requirements for completing the Renewal Licence for Seven Sisters to Manitoba Conservation and Climate in 2018. We would like to highlight that Units 1 to 4 were refurbished between 1992 and 1998, increasing the total generating station capacity from 167.8 to 180.6 MW.

Manitoba Hydro continues to operate the Seven Sisters Generating Station in compliance with the Second STEL. The supporting documentation provided in 2010 prior to issuance of the STELs is still valid and ongoing compliance with the licence is documented in our Annual Water Levels and Flows Compliance Report.
