## INFLUENZA IN MANITOBA – 2009/2010 SEASON

## Update: April 21st, 2010

The public health disease surveillance system of Manitoba Health received its first laboratory-confirmed positive case of influenza for the 2009/2010 season (running from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010) during the week of July 1 to July 4, 2009. This season there have been **1887** laboratory-confirmed cases of Influenza A, of which **1866** were laboratory-confirmed cases of pandemic H1N1 (pH1N1), and **0** lab-confirmed cases of Influenza B in the province. There has been no influenza activity since the last complete report dated January **30**, 2010.

N.B. No further weekly reports will be produced unless there is influenza activity identified. A final year-end report will be produced in July 2010 following the end of the 2009/2010 influenza season, which concludes June 30, 2010.
