In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

Intermountain Sport Fishing Enhancement Inc.: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a public use boat launch facility on the municipal road allowance east of NE 28-27-18W in the Rural Municipality of Dauphin, subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated January 4, 1993, and additional information contained in a letter dated March 16, 1993, both submitted to Manitoba Environment by Intermountain Sport Fishing Enhancement Inc.
- 2) The Licencee shall not undertake site preparation or construction activities associated with the Development which could disturb the ground until a site inspection has been completed by the Historic Resources Branch of Manitoba Culture, Heritage and Citizenship.
- 3) The Licencee shall, prior to beginning any clearing of the Development site, obtain a timber permit from Manitoba Natural Resources.
- 4) The Licencee shall not, between April 15 and June 1 of any year of construction, undertake riverbank alteration activities associated with the Development.
- 5) The Licencee shall reseed all areas of exposed soil with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 6) The Licencee shall ensure that the finished elevation at the top of the boat launch ramp is not lower than the elevation at the top of the adjacent natural riverbank and that no lower ground elevations are present between the natural riverbanks and the boat launch ramp.
- 7) The Licencee shall ensure that the finished elevation of the north-south access road and the parking area east of NE 28-27-18W and adjacent to the boat launch ramp does not exceed the elevation of the adjacent natural riverbank.

- 8) The Licencee shall ensure that the two natural drainage outlets which provide drainage for the area between the Valley River and the access road to the Development are maintained at their natural water conveyance capacities. These outlets are located at sites 5 and 6 shown on page 4 of enclosure 5 of the Proposal, and are respectively approximately 340 m and 430 m north of the east-west municipal road which is south of the Development. The finished elevation of the access road at these locations is not to exceed the elevation of the natural profile, and culverts are not to be installed at these locations.
- 9) The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 10) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.

Revocation

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
