pursuant to section 13 of the Act for the construction of the Development being a bulk granular fertilizer handling facility, at 337 Railway St. in the Town of Grandview in the Rural Municipality of Grandview and the installation of equipment therein subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:


DEFINITIONS

In this Licence,

"chemical products" includes but is not limited to petroleum products, fertilizers and pesticides.

LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall not receive, handle or store chemical products, other than those needed for construction purposes, at the above noted location until a Licence is issued under the Act for this purpose.
2. The Licencee undertakes construction with the full knowledge that compliance will be required for all specifications, limits, terms and conditions which may be determined and included in any subsequent stage of Licence issued under the Act for this Development. This would include any remedial measures or alterations to the construction works which may be required by the Director after an environmental impact assessment of the development is completed, or for any other reason pertaining to the safety of the construction and subsequent operation of the development. Such remedial measures or alterations shall be undertaken within a time frame to be specified by the Director, and in a manner to be approved by the Director.
3. If in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee is in contravention of or has contravened the specifications, limits, terms and conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
