## Apprenticeship and Certification - General Regulation Update

On January 27, 2023, the Manitoba government amended the Apprenticeship and Certification – General Regulation, Manitoba Regulation 11/2023. The following information details the change that has been made to the regulation, which is effective immediately.

## **Designated Trainers**

The Designated Trainer Provision is extended to March 1, 2028. This means that designated trainers will continue to be permitted to train apprentices under the Apprenticeship and Certification – General Regulation until March 1, 2028.

A designated trainer is an experienced, but uncertified, tradesperson that is equivalent to a journeyperson for the purpose of apprentice supervision.

## **Commonly Asked Question**

How can I become a designated trainer?

Applications to become a designated trainer are considered in voluntary trades only. To become a designated trainer, experienced tradespeople must complete a Designated Trainer Application and a Work Experience Form to demonstrate significant knowledge and experience in the trade (a minimum of 70% of scope of trade).
