

FDC PILOT PLANT

GOOD MANUFACTURING PRACTICES (GMPs)

October 2005

- Footwear and smocks must be removed prior to leaving the production area for breaks.
- Staff and clients must not leave the facility wearing designated clothing and footwear.
- Smocks must not be worn or stored in washrooms, lunch rooms or locker areas.
- Food, drinks, chewing gum and tobacco are not permitted in food production areas.
- Taste testing is not allowed in the production areas.
- Personal food such as lunches must be stored in the lunch rooms.
- Eating and drinking is confined to the designated lunch rooms.
- Hands must be washed upon entering the production areas.
- Washing must be done after contamination.
- Scratching of heads, face, etc. or placing fingers in or around the face is unacceptable in the production areas.
- Spitting and coughing in the production areas are unacceptable.
- Jewelry (rings, watches, bracelets, necklaces, piercings) is not to be worn in the production areas. Medic Alert jewelry is the only acceptable jewelry for the production areas.
- Hair nets (and beard nets) must be worn in the production areas.
- Individuals with cuts, wounds, sores, boils, etc. must not handle food or have contact with food in the production areas unless the injury is completely protected by a secure waterproof covering.
- Food products and ingredients must not be stored on the floor. Food products and ingredients must be stored on shelves, tables, pallets, etc.
