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How to Use The Personal Training Assessment Tool

Upon completion of the questionnaire, a review of the answers should be undertaken to assign further priorities to your own identified needs. A question answered (No, Yes, Yes) indicates a training priority need, versus a question answered (Yes, No, No) indicating training is not required. Once the review is completed, skill areas will have been identified. Below each question is the heading Skill Area. The Skill Area provides a cross reference to training courses approved within the Project 2000/Bridging Generations Initiative Management Credit Training Program Course Catalogue for consideration.

In some cases, the courses that will be identified through this process require prerequisite courses to be completed (this is noted in the Management Training Credit Course Catalogue). Also, available in the same catalogue in Section 7.1, are several course offerings for consideration if you wish to upgrade your skill level prior to undertaking some of the other potential courses identified by this training assessment tool.
