

## MANITOBA AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS, TO THE UNITED STATES, 1995 – 2006

- Manitoba agri-food exports to the US were \$1.597 billion in 2006, up 1.07% from 2005 levels.
- Manitoba's agri-food exports to all destinations were \$3.087 billion in 2006, up 4.3% from 2005.
- The US accounted for 51.75% of Manitoba's total agri-food exports in 2006, up less than 0.1% from 51.67% in 2005. This consisted of 19.2% unprocessed goods, 55.3% of the semi-processed and 25.5% processed.
- Combined hog and pork exports to the US in 2006 totaled \$493.1 million, down 13.5% from 2005 and 10.2% from 2004. Hog and pork exports to the US in 2006 accounted for virtually all hogs and 30.6% of total pork exports to all destinations.

### Unprocessed/Bulk:

- 2006 unprocessed or bulk exports increased 1.4% from 2005 levels to account for 19.2% of Manitoba's total exports to the US. Bulk exports, primarily field crops, were valued at \$306.4 million.
- In 2006, bulk oat exports totaled \$125.5 million, while bulk wheat exports were \$34.0 million.
- In 2006, Manitoba exported \$53.5 million in bulk canola to the US.


### Semi-Processed/Intermediate:

- Semi-processed exports accounted for 55.3% of the total exported to the US, and were primarily products from hogs, beef, canola oil and meal, pulse crops and oat groats, meal and flakes. Exports were a record \$883.4 million, 4.0% more than 2005.
- Canola oil exports to the USA were \$159.5 million with meal exports of \$32.6 million, a combined increase of 18.2% over 2005. That represented virtually all of Manitoba's total canola oil and meal exports.
- Manitoba's live cattle and bison exports were all attributed to direct US shipments. In 2006, the total value of exports increased 53.4% from a year earlier to \$183.2 million. With the 2005 re-opening of the US border to live animal exports, current export levels represent a gradual rebuilding of live animal trade with the US.
- Exports of hogs to the US were valued at \$373.9 million in 2006, down 10.5% from 2005. Virtually all of Manitoba's hogs were exported to the US.

### Processed/Consumer:

- Processed exports accounted for 25.5% of Manitoba's total exports to the US and were primarily potato products, pork and honey. Processed exports to the US totaled \$407.4 million in 2006, 5.0% less than in 2005.
- 32.4% of Manitoba's processed pork and all processed beef exports go to the US. Global processed pork exports totaled \$389.8 million in 2006, down 16.7% from 2005, while processed beef exports totaled \$1.58 million.
- Processed potato exports to the US totaled a record \$249.6 million in 2006, an increase of 2.1% over 2005 levels. The US accounts for 92.6% of Manitoba's total processed potato exports to all destinations.
