

FARM CASH RECEIPTS ESTIMATES JANUARY – JUNE 2007^R - 2009^P

From January to June of 2009 in Manitoba, estimated farm cash receipts totaled \$2.48 billion, up 0.07% from the same period last year, supported by crop prices that reflected concerns over tight global supplies. By comparison, total Canadian farm cash receipts in the first half of 2009 were down 1.4% from the same six-month period one year earlier.

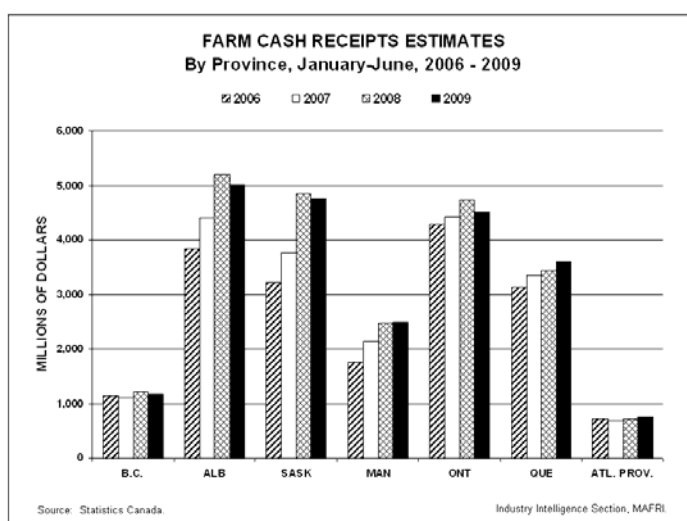
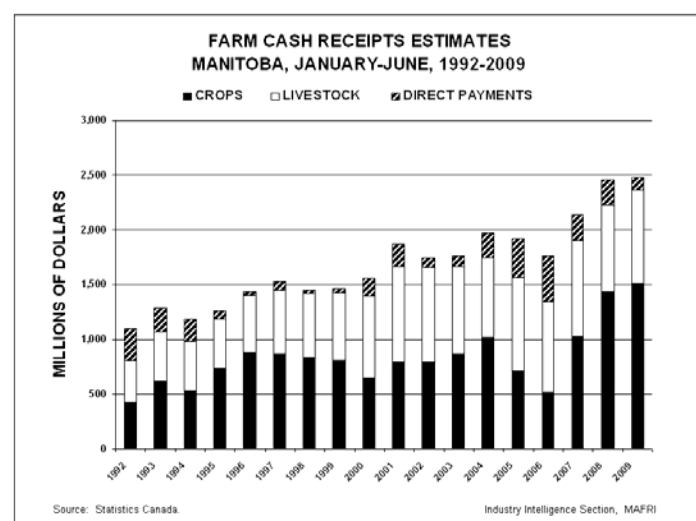
Revenues from crops in Manitoba during the first six months of 2009 reached close to \$1.518 billion, an increase of 5.9% from \$1.433 billion in the same period last year, due mainly to strong sales, particularly for canola and wheat. Although prices have retreated somewhat from highs set in 2008 and market demand has been strong.

Manitoba's livestock revenues from January to June of 2009 were \$842.6 million, up 7.0% from the same period in 2008, reflecting producer resilience in spite of continuing high feed costs, inventory reductions, US Country of Origin Labeling legislation, concerns with H1N1 and the economic crisis which put downward pressure on US demand for live animals.

In the first half of 2009, program payments in Manitoba totaled \$117.1 million, a drop of 50.8% from \$238.2 million the same time period the previous year. Crop insurance payments were \$38.9 million the first six months of 2009.
