
Dauphin River

Community Status

Two closely related and adjoining communities are known as Dauphin River. One community is located on the Dauphin River Indian Reserve and the second community, formerly known as Anama Bay, is on adjacent provincial Crown land.

The community of Dauphin River is found at the mouth of the Dauphin River, where it enters Sturgeon Bay, a part of Lake Winnipeg. The main portion of the community is about 5 kilometres long and is situated on the north shore of the river. It is approximately 378 km north of Winnipeg and 72 km north of Gypsumville. PR #513 provides access to Gypsumville and to PTH #6.

Since recognition in March 1970, the community has operated under *The Northern Affairs Act* and is represented by a mayor and council.

Medical response is limited to the resources of the community health worker in Dauphin River. A nurse visits from Fairford; otherwise it is necessary to transport the patient to the medical clinic in Ashern. The nearest hospital is located at Ashern, and the nearest ambulance is based in Gypsumville at (204) 659-2500.
