# Little Grand Rapids

---

## Community Status

Two communities, related and adjacent, share the name of Little Grand Rapids. One is the Little Grand Rapids Indian Reserve, the other the Little Grand Rapids Community on nearby provincial Crown land. All information in this report relates to the non-treaty community unless noted.

The community is located 240 air km Northeast of Winnipeg on the shore of Family Lake, where it empties into Fishing Lake.

The community is represented by a contact person under *The Northern Affairs Act*.

## Emergency Services

### Fire

No organized fire protection service is available.

### Police

Police response is from the Little Grand Rapids detachment, RCMP, located on the reserve, phone (204) 397-2133 for emergencies or (204) 397-2249 for the office.

### Medical

Medical response is based on the federal nursing station, which is across the bay on the reserve. There are 4 nurses and patients are air lifted to Winnipeg as required.

## Community-based Services

### Airstrip

Manitoba Transportation and Government Services, Northern Manitoba Airports operate a 2,800' x 75' crushed rock strip with terminal and remote-controlled lighting on the edge of the community. Office is in Winnipeg, phone (204) 945-3421, or the airport manager, phone (204) 397-2012.

Provided by Manitoba Hydro as land line electric power. Residential rates are:
