Mandate:

In *Beyond Kyoto: Manitoba's Green Future* the Government of Manitoba committed to forming an Active Transportation Advisory Group to provide recommendations to the Minister on expanding active transportation opportunities in the province. The group's mandate will be completed when the report is presented to the Minister.

Responsibilities:

Provide a report containing advice and recommendations to the Minister of Conservation on expanding active transportation activities in the province.

Membership:

Members appointed by the Minister of Science, Technology, Energy and Mines. The members of the Active Transportation Advisory Group should have experience in the following areas:

1. Urban and rural planning and transportation;
2. Road safety, cycling;
3. Healthy living;
4. Access for persons with disabilities and other related areas.

Length of Terms:

Desirable Expertise:

An effective board member must be able to conduct research and disseminate written material on the subject, analyze written and verbal information in order to ascertain facts, and apply relevant legislation to this written and verbal information.

Board members must also have a combination of the following:

- Active listening skills;
- Be able to read and interpret policies/legislation and how it applies to the case;
- Be able use plain language.

Time commitment:

The Active Transportation Advisory Group meets approximately once a month for a full day.

Remuneration:

The Chair and Board Members receive \$100 per meeting they attend plus applicable expenses.
