ca. 1800 Came to Canada  
1803 at Kaministikwia [Fort William]  
1808 Placed in charge of Sir Alexander Mackenzie's affairs in Canada after he returned to Europe  
1814 Entered McTavish, McGillivrays & Company which had been co-agent with Sir Alexander Mackenzie and Company for the NWC  
Placed in charge of publicity during the Selkirk controversy  
1821 Relations strained with his partners after amalgamation  
1827 Published a letter to Simon McGillivray  
1832, 28 June Died of cholera

Wife: Anne Bethune, youngest sister of Angus Bethune
