**An Outfit year ran from 1 June to 31 May*

1869, 23 April

entered into a contract with Donald Smith to take from the HBC the fishing post at Paul's Island for two years. He was to provide crew, craft and gear, with the HBC providing 2/3 of nets and lines. All the fish were to go to HBC, with the Company paying regular prices at Davis Inlet for 2/3, and the other 1/3 going to the HBC. The HBC was also to provide traps for 1/4 of the furs caught, and get paid for the rest. He was also to be allowed ordinary prices for cod and trout and 7 shillings per pair for "best Esquimaux boots".
