On the 9<sup>th</sup> {May 1895}, at Cannes Sir Cyril Clerke Graham, C.M.G. fifth baronet of Kirkstall, third son of Sir Sandford Graham, second baronet, was attached to Lord Dufferin's Mission to Syria, 1860-1; Private Secretary to Lord Carnarvon when Colonial Secretary, 1866-7; Special Commissioner, to Canada and Hudson {sic} Bay Territory, 1870-1; Lieutenant-Governor of Grenada, 1875-7. Married, 1874, Louisa Frederica, daughter of Rev. Lord Charles Hervey, D.D.
