

Fiche de renseignements des ACBH : Publications de la Hudson's Bay Record Society

La Hudson's Bay Record Society a été fondée le 29 avril 1938 afin de publier des recueils de certains documents des Archives de la Compagnie de la Baie d'Hudson, notamment de procès-verbaux, de correspondances et de journaux relatant des activités commerciales et d'exploration. Les douze premiers volumes ont été publiés annuellement par la Champlain Society, sous la direction de E.E. Rich, éditeur-en-chef. En vertu d'une entente conclue en 1936, la Champlain Society publie aussi un nombre limité de volumes à l'intention des membres de la Hudson's Bay Record Society, sous forme de tirage à part de sa « série de la Compagnie de la Baie d'Hudson ». A cause de l'augmentation des coûts d'imprimerie qui se produit pendant l'après-guerre, ce double tirage devient impossible pour la Champlain Society et elle met fin à son entente avec la Hudson's Bay Record Society en 1949. La Compagnie de la Baie d'Hudson assume donc dès lors l'entière responsabilité des publications.

De 1960 à 1983, des volumes sont publiés tous les deux ans et ne sont offerts qu'à environ 1150 membres. La Hudson's Bay Record Society est démantelée en 1983. Son dernier recueil, publié en 1981, est le volume XXXIII intitulé *Letters of Charles John Brydges, 1883-89* (Lettres de Charles John Brydges, 1883-1889).
