HERITAGE GRANTS PROGRAM COMMITTEE

Heritage Grants Program Committee members will also base their decision on:

QUALITY OR MERIT OF PROJECT

- 1. The degree to which the project contributes to the identification, protection or interpretation of Manitoba's heritage.
- 2. The degree to which the project meets or exceeds generally accepted standards for the discipline.
- 3. The extent to which the project's benefits are accessible to the community at large (i.e., relative to the community it serves).
- 4. The extent to which the project demonstrates leadership and a useful example to the community.

DO-ABILITY OF THE PROJECT

- 1. The adequacy of the proposed budget to complete the project.
- 2. The capability of the organization to complete the project.
- 3. The feasibility of the project, in terms of objectives, schedule and methods.
- 4. The availability of human and financial resources to carry out the project and maintain it after completion (e.g., the degree of volunteer and community support for the project).
