Heritage Grants Advisory Council members will also base their decision on:

QUALITY OR MERIT OF PROJECT

1. The degree to which the project contributes to the identification, protection or interpretation of Manitoba's heritage.
2. The degree to which the project meets or exceeds generally accepted standards for the discipline.
3. The extent to which the project's benefits are accessible to the community at large (i.e., relative to the community it serves).
4. The extent to which the project demonstrates leadership and a useful example to the community.

DO-ABILITY OF THE PROJECT

1. The adequacy of the proposed budget to complete the project.
2. The capability of the organization to complete the project.
3. The feasibility of the project, in terms of objectives, schedule and methods.
4. The availability of human and financial resources to carry out the project and maintain it after completion (e.g., the degree of volunteer and community support for the project).
