The following terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the construction and operation of a 115 KV transformer station to service Sherridon, Manitoba:

- The Applicant shall construct and operate the 115 KV transformer station in accordance with The Transmission and Stations Engineering and Construction Report No. 88-D1, dated March, 1988, and as prepared by B. Manning.
- 2. The Applicant shall investigate the feasibility of constructing on-site containment pits as a precautionary measure to prevent environmental impacts in the event of spill or leak of insulating oil. A report on the feasibility investigation shall be submitted to the Director on or before January 1, 1989.
- 3. The Applicant shall enclose the transformer station site with a six foot high fence and install Danger Warning signs in both English and Cree along the fence at this location.
- 4. This Licence replaces Licence No. 1201 which is hereby rescinded.
