THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

## THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being the relocation of Provincial Road #489 located in the LGD of Mountain beginning at the intersection with Provincial Road #271 located 3.2 km. east of the existing PR #489/ PR #271 intersection and extending in a northerly direction a distance of 6.0 km. subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

## SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal, Proposed Relocation of Provincial Road #489 (from PR #271 6.0 km North).
- 2) The Licencee shall construct all drainages along the relocated right-of-way in accordance with the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba.
- 3) The Licencee shall rehabilitate and stabilize the abandoned right-of-way in accordance with the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba, Part 7 Abandonment Guides.
- 4) The Licencee shall maintain the abandoned right-of-way under Crown ownership as part of the Garland River buffer.
- 5) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from the high water line of the Garland River, and shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.

The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 150/91R respecting Waste Disposal Grounds.

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
