THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

Manitoba Northern Affairs: "the Licencee"

for the construction and maintenance of the Development being a bridge and causeway over the West Waterhen River in W 10-34-16W subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated October 25, 1993, submitted by I. D. Engineering Canada Inc. on behalf of the Licencee.
- 2. The Licencee shall not undertake construction, demolition or maintenance activities which would lead to river channel erosion or sedimentation between April 15 and June 15 of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall ensure that construction practices comply with the requirements of the Manitoba Natural Resources publication "Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba".
- 4. The Licencee shall reseed soil which is exposed as a result of construction or demolition activities and which is not subjected to high velocity flows with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 5. The Licencee shall riprap riverbank areas which are exposed as a result of construction or demolition activities and which are subjected to high velocity flows.
- 6. The Licencee shall remove all material associated with the existing bridge and stabilize the bed and banks of the river at that location with riprap or revegetation.
- 7. The Licencee shall inspect the Development periodically and replace any riprap or rockfill which may be displaced by high flows.

- 8. The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 9. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.

Revocation

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
