THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE TURTLE RIVER WATERSHED CONSERVATION DISTRICT #2: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a stream rehabilitation project in sections 20, 29 and 32-24-17W and 5-25-17W in the Rural Municipality of Ochre River subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications. Limits. Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Licencee shall construct and operate the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated May 27, 1993, supplementary letters dated April 14, 1994 to Manitoba Environment and May 10, 1994 to the Manitoba Fisheries Branch, and Drawing Number AEC-247 dated February 17, 1994.
- 2. The Licencee shall not undertake instream construction activities associated with the Development between April 1 and June 15 of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall contact the Fisheries Branch of Manitoba Natural Resources advising of the anticipated construction schedule for the Development at least two weeks prior to construction.
- 4. The Licencee shall take appropriate measures during the construction of the Development to ensure that exposed soil does not enter waterbodies as a result of construction activities or subsequent erosion.
- 5. The Licencee shall revegetate soil exposed during the construction of the Development with native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 6. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous waste generated by the machinery used in the construction and operation of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislative requirements.
- 7. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction and operation of the Development shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
