## THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: the "Licencee"

for the construction of the Development being the upgrading of a section of Provincial Road #433 located in the Rural Municipality of Lac du Bonnet beginning at the junction of Provincial Road #313 and extending along the roadway 4.51 km. north subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

## SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal, Proposed Upgrading of Provincial Road #433 (from PR #313 to 4.51 km. north) R.M. of Lac du Bonnet, dated March 6, 1995.
- 2. The Licencee shall, from April 1 to June 15 of each year during construction, cease all construction activities that may impact upon Duchinski Creek.
- 3. The Licencee shall, during construction, adhere to the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Guidelines titled Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba.
- 4. The Licencee shall, during construction, comply with all requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
- 5. The Licencee shall, upon completion of construction, cleanup and remove all debris from the construction site and dispose of the debris at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to *Manitoba Regulation* 150/91 respecting *Waste Disposal Grounds*.
