AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: The Clean Environment Commission and North West Packers Ltd., applicant.

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, North West Packers Ltd., 2 Speers Road, St. Boniface, Winnipeg has submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of an animal food processing and freezing plant located on Lot 292, Plan 433 Parish Lot Roman Catholic Mission Property, at or near 2 Speers Road, St. Boniface in the City of Winnipeg.

AND WHEREAS

a representation was made to the Clean Environment Commission by a person who is or is likely to be affected an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation,

AND WHEREAS

the Clean Environment Commission relatively public hearing on the 26th, 27th and 28th days of June 1922 Lanche Archwood School in St. Boniface, City of Winnipeg, Maritoba,

AND WHEREAS

the Clean Environment Commission Considered the application on the 22nd day of January

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1) The applicant hall ensure that at any point of impingement of the plant bremises the atmosphere contains less than seven (7) occur units per standard cubic foot,
- 2) The applicant shall ensure that a high standard of maintenance and housekeeping is carried out at all times in all parts of the premises so as to meet the requirement of clause 1),
- 3) The applicant shall inform the Clean Environment Commission in writing before proceeding with any change in the nature of the operation which may affect the quality of the environment of the plant site.
