

Water and Wastewater Refresher Courses - Spring 2017

Consistent with the past number of years Red River College will be offering a full suite of certification exam preparation courses in the spring of 2017. In addition to offering courses in Winnipeg, some courses are being held regionally through our college affiliates.

Winnipeg Based Courses

All of the Winnipeg based courses and the associated certification exams are held at Red River College's Notre Dame Campus and the course costs include parking and lunches. With the exception of the Foundations Course (5 days of instruction and no exam) all of the courses run from Monday through Thursday (8:00 am - 4:00 pm) with the exam being administered on the Friday morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Students who cancel their registration 7 days or less before the start of the course will be charged a \$100.00 fee.

Water and Wastewater Foundations (Course Code: WATR-1007)

Five-day course: April 24 - 28, 2017

Fee: \$1020.00 Registration deadline: April 7, 2017

This former basic mathematics and science courses has been expanded. It will continue to assist operators with the basic mathematics and science skills required to take the Manitoba Class I and Class II Certification courses. Participants will solve problems related to the fields of water treatment and distribution, wastewater treatment and collection. Participants will learn a basic understanding of chemistry, microbiology, hydraulics and electricity. However, the course will now *also* include the following general topics: Administration and Management, Equipment and Support Systems, and Safety.

Water Treatment I (Course Code: CONF-1077)

Four-day course: May 1 - 4, 2017

Fee: \$825.00 Registration deadline: April 14, 2015

Exam Date: May 5, 2017, RRC

This course is intended as preparation for the Manitoba Water Treatment Class I Certification Exam. Topics include: hydrologic cycle; ground water systems; slow sand filtration; chlorination; testing/sampling; water treatment dosage calculations; detention time/flow rate calculations.

Water Distribution I & II (Course Code: WATR-1010)

Four-day course: May 8 - 11, 2017

Fee: \$825.00 Registration deadline: April 21, 2017

Exam Date: May 12, 2017, RRC

This course is intended as preparation for the Manitoba Water Distribution Class I or Class II Certification Exams. Topics include: hydrologic cycle; ground water systems; hydrants/valves/meters; piping standards; chlorination; testing/sampling; pipeline dosage calculations; detention time/flow rate calculations; backflow/cross connection; piping standards; trenching/bedding standards; tapping; leak detection; corrosion control.

Wastewater Collection I & II (Course Code: WATR-1003)

Four-day course: May 15 - May 18, 2017

Fee: \$825.00 Registration deadline: April 28, 2017

Exam Date: May 19, 2017, RRC

This course is intended as preparation for the Manitoba Wastewater Collection Class I or Class II Certification Exams. Topics include: manholes/lift stations; backflow/cross connections; piping standards; trenching/ bedding standards; odor/corrosion control; lift station calculations; detention time/flow rate calculations; chlorination and testing/sampling.

Wastewater Treatment I (Course Code: CONF-1065)

Four-day course: May 29 - June 1, 2017

Fee: \$825.00 Registration deadline: May 12, 2017

Exam Date: June 2, 2017, RRC

This course is intended as preparation for the Manitoba Wastewater Treatment Class I Certification Exam. Topics include: lagoons; chlorination/odor control; testing/sampling; wastewater treatment dosage calculations; detention time/flow rate calculations.

Water Treatment II (Course Code: CONF-1089)

Four-day course: June 5-8, 2017

Fee: \$825.00 Registration deadline: May 19, 2017

Exam Date: June 9, 2017, RRC

This course is intended as preparation for the Manitoba Water Treatment Class II Certification Exam. Topics include: surface water systems; backflow/cross connection; lime/soda ash softening; rapid sand filtration; ion exchange; membrane filtration; taste odor control; fluoride; UV disinfection; testing/sampling; chlorination; disinfection; water treatment dosage calculations; detention time/flow rate calculations.

Wastewater Treatment II (Course Code: CONF-1067)

Four-day course: June 12 - 15, 2017

Fee: \$825.00 Registration deadline: May 26, 2017

Exam Date: June 16, 2017, RRC

This course is intended as preparation for the Manitoba Wastewater Treatment Class II Certification Exam. Topics include: wastewater characteristics; treatment processes; mathematical calculations; microbiological control; sampling & testing; laboratory equipment & practices; selection, operations & maintenance of equipment; safety, security & administration.

NOTE: Though there are no formal pre-requisites required to take Certification Exam Preparation Courses, it is assumed that participants possess the fundamental math, science, equipment, and safety skills required to understand the course material. Individuals who do not possess these skills should be taking the five day Water and Wastewater Foundations Course prior to registering for any Certification Exam Preparation Courses.

To establish who should be taking the Foundations Course RRC has developed a diagnostics quiz designed to objectively assess an individual's fundamental math, science, equipment and safety skills required to effectively participate in a Certification Exam Preparation Course. All individuals that have not taken the Foundations Course in the past or have not successfully passed a Water and Wastewater Certification exam should complete the quiz. Exam Registration

The Water and Wastewater Certification Preparation Course fees do not include the cost of the exam(s). All certification exams are arranged and registered by Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship. It is the course participant's responsibility to register and make payment for the exam to Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship no later than 14 days prior to the exam date.
