Re: Selkirk wastewater treatment plant - wastewater effluent limit for phosphorus in effect January 1, 2016

As you have been previously notified, your wastewater treatment plant is required to meet the 1 mg/L phosphorus limit as of January 1, 2016 in accordance with the Water Quality Standards, Objectives and Guidelines Regulation under *The Water Protection Act*.

Your wastewater treatment plant operates under Environment Act Licence 2265 R. In addition to meeting the 1 mg/L phosphorus limit and in accordance with Clause 2 and 20 of Licence 2265 R, you are hereby required to sample, analyze and report on the total phosphorus content of your wastewater effluent prior to discharging to surface water.
