

## Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

### **DUNN-RITE FOOD PRODUCTS LTD. POULTRY PROCESSING PLANT EXPANSION** **– FILE: 1805.10**

A proposal was filed on behalf of Dunn-Rite Food Products Ltd. for the expansion and operation of the Dunn-Rite poultry processing plant located on 199 Hamelin Street in the City of Winnipeg. Proposed changes to the poultry processing plant include the installation of a wastewater pre-treatment system and an increased production rate to approximately 100,000 chickens per day. Wastewater effluent from the facility is discharged to the City of Winnipeg for treatment.
