## RE: Environment Act Licence Suspension Discharge of Notre Dame de Lourdes Wastewater Treatment Lagoon

This letter acknowledges the request submitted by the Municipality of Lorne on September 8, 2016, to commence discharge of effluent from the secondary cell of the Notre Dame de Lourdes Wastewater Lagoon without meeting the effluent limit for total coliform specified in Environment Act Licence No. 1125.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 2(c) of Environment Act Licence No. 1125 pursuant to Section 18(1) of *The Environment Act* which allows you to proceed with the discharge of the secondary cell of the lagoon. The suspension is in effect from September 12, 2016, to September 26, 2016, inclusive for this event.

Please be advised that if weather conditions become unsuitable, discharge must cease and authorization may be revoked. All other clauses in Environment Act Licence No. 1125 remain in effect.
