Here are my comments on this EAP:

The following paragraph appears on page 7 of the Environment Act Proposal for this project:

An application for a new Water Rights Act Licence for the RM of Headingley WTP will be required. Based on average day demand the current annual allocation of water to the CRWC would be sufficient to meet the needs of both the St. Eustache WTP (1070 dam³) and the Headingley WTP (2735 dam³).

The Water Use Licensing Section (WULS) is in agreement that a separate application will be required for this project as it represents a separate point of diversion on the Assiniboine River and a separate service area from the existing St. Eustache WTP.

We are also in agreement that the water use requirement for the new plant at Headingly should come out of the current allocation of the St. Eustache WTP as there is sufficient water set aside for both projects in the licence for the existing plant at St. Eustache.


