The proposed development consists of the following: a new aerated primary cell; a new secondary cell; and a phosphorous removal system with 3 backwash ponds. Treated wastewater from the wastewater treatment lagoon will be discharged between June 15<sup>th</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup> of any year via the Seine River Diversion to Red River.
