Re: Notice of Alteration for Short Term plan for Riverton Facility of ErosionControlBlanekt.com Inc.

I would like to inform your Department that ErosionControlBlanket.com Inc (ECB) is still our Legal name incorporated in the Province of Manitoba. We are now operating as ECBVerdyol to the general public, thus the name and logo change on our letterhead.

I am requesting a Notice of Alteration for my license # 2600 Client File #18690 as discussed in my meeting with Kim Kmet, Donna Smiley and Mike Baert on Feb 14, 2017.

Short term plan (present day till March 1, 2018)

- 1. ECB to develop and commission a plan to install a baler operation on site to compress any excess waste from Group 2 and Group 3. This will allow ECB to sell the excess straw waste to local farmers and composters.
- 2. ECB be allowed during this time to haul and burn any excess waste from Group 2 and Group 3 (per our ECB Waste Management Plan in Appendix 1) to SW 15-23-4E.

#### Long Term Plan

- 1. Utilize BAR for waste from Group 1 and Group 6.
- 2. ECB to construct an approved burn cell at the property SW 15-23-4E
- 3. ECB to eventually purchase 15 acres that includes the burn area (in progress but need to subdivide the land) not sure on the timing of that as it is not 100% in my control.
- 4. Group 2 will be hauled to SW 15-23-4E
- 5. Group 3 will be bales and sold to Composting groups in the area and Dairy farmers. The baling of the fiber will be that it will be able to be stored in farmers sheds on a regular bases, it will also allow us to transport the straw to farther location. There may be a small portion of this product that will need to be burned at SW 15-23-4E if needed.





6. Group 4 and Group 5 waste will be disposed of in the same manner as in the plan.

Ms. Braun, since BAR waste and the RM of Bifrost has sent us a letter refusing our burnable waste in the quantity we are manufacturing we request the short term plan alternation be approved as soon as you can so we can haul our accumulating waste.

Thank you for your consideration, we are more than happy to work with your team during this transition to our License.

### **ECB Waste Management Plan (current)**

ECB is classifying their waste streams into the following classes with the

#### Group 1- Landfilled:

Plastics- Net left on master rolls
Thread left on cores
Plastic strapping form coir bales
Baler twine

Waste ECB Rolls that contain plastic net and thread

Action: Hauled to Bar waste to be landfilled

#### Group 2- Organic:

Waste ECB Rolls with Bionet, Waste Straw large Cardboard Boxes Thread cores Net cores wood pallets

Action: Haul to SW 15-23-4E to be burned

### Group 3- Straw used for recycling:

**Short Straw** 

**Action**: Used for Stenlogs or hauled to Sigurdson Dairy barns, if straw is not usable them haul to SW 15-23-4E property for burning.

## Group 4- Selkirk Recycling:

Steel

Action: Hauled to Selkirk once we have a full truck

# Group 5- Riverdale recycling:

Pop cans Small Cardboard

Action: Collect till Riverdale Workshop picks up

### **Group 6** – Used oil and fluids

Transmission oil Motor Oil Grease Lube's

Action: Hauled to Bar Waste
