A proposal has been received from Steckley Consulting Engineers Inc. on behalf of the Rural Municipality of Stanley for the removal of sludge from the Rural Municipality's wastewater treatment lagoon in NW 11-2-5W, and the land application of the sludge on portions of NE 11-2-5W and SW 14-2-5W. The sludge would be applied by subsurface injection in the spring of 2013 before seeding, or in the fall of 2013 after harvesting, in accordance with crop nutrient requirements and in accordance with the *Nutrient Management Regulation* (Manitoba Regulation 62/2008).
