

- Can the RM of Stanley please provide the locations of the receiving lands? Under the Nutrient Management Regulation (62/2008), no nutrients are to be applied to Zone N4 soils.
- Can the RM of Stanley please provide soil tests for the receiving lands? The Nutrient Management Regulation (62/2008) requires that in nutrient management zone N1, N2, and N3 where Olsen soil test P, within the top 15 cm, is from 60 to <120 ppm the allowable nutrient application is at 2 times the crop removal rate of P<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub>. If Olsen soil test P is 120 to <180 ppm the application is 1 times the crop removal rate of P<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub>.
- In a given year, the Nutrient Management Regulation (62/2008) requires that no person shall apply sludge between November 10 and April 10.
- The Water Quality Management Section is concerned with any discharges that have the potential to impact the aquatic environment and/or restrict present and future uses of the water. Therefore it is recommended that the license require the proponent to actively participate in any future watershed based management study, plan/or nutrient reduction program, approved by the Director.
