

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

OLYWEST MB LIMITED PARTNERSHIP – OLYWEST PORK PROCESSING FACILITY – ST. BONIFACE INDUSTRIAL PARK (File: 5155.00)

Manitoba Conservation is in receipt of an Environment Act Proposal from OlyWest MB Limited Partnership for the construction and operation of a new hog processing plant to be located within the St. Boniface Industrial Park of the City of Winnipeg, and involving:

- the receipt, slaughtering and processing of up to 9,000 hogs per day or 45,000 hogs per week;
 - the continuous release of pre-treated wastewater into the City of Winnipeg's sewage collection system;
 - the management and recycling or disposal of any organic waste, blood, sludge, manure, and solid waste; and
 - the management and minimization of noise and odours;
- as would be associated with the construction and operation of the proposed Development.

Anyone likely to be affected by the above operation and who wishes to provide comments either for or against the proposal should contact the Director of Environmental Assessment and Licensing, in writing at the address listed below, not later than OCTOBER 10, 2006.
