## Re: Winpak Ltd. – Notice of Alteration

Thank you for the Notice of Alteration (NoA) submitted on November 26, 2015 that proposes the following alterations at the Winpak facility located at 100 Saulteaux Crescent in Winnipeg:

- 1. Equipment layout rearrangement without any change to the building footprint.
- 2. Addition of one new slitter that does not result in VOC emission.
- 3. Decommissioning of one blown film extrusion line (EC1) and one solvent based laminate (Polytype laminator).
- 4. Addition of one new Multibarrier 4 Machine that does not result in VOC emission.

I have concluded that the environmental effects from the NoA are insignificant; therefore, in accordance with Section 14(2) of *The Environment Act* you are hereby authorized to carry out the proposed alteration as described in the November 26, 2015 NoA. This approval is conditional upon the submission of a revised floor plan upon completion of the alterations.
