Re: Winpak Ltd. - Notice of Alteration

Thank you for the Notice of Alteration (NoA) submitted on October 4, 2017 that proposes the following alterations at the Winpak facility located at 100 Saulteaux Crescent in Winnipeg:

- 1. Equipment layout rearrangement without any change to the building footprint.
- 2. Addition of one new slitter that does not result in VOC emission.
- 3. Addition of one new Multiwin 5 Machine that does not result in VOC emission.
- 4. Addition of an exhaust system for extruder heat removal
