An Environment Act Proposal has been filed by the City of Steinbach for a supplemental groundwater supply for the City's water treatment and distribution system. The proposal involves the development of two wells in NW 3-7-6E near Park Road West, a new water treatment facility and pipeline connections to the City's existing water distribution system. The new wells are proposed to supply up to 1,000 dam³ of water annually, capable of meeting the City's estimated requirements to 2038 in combination with the City's existing wellfield at 515 Main Street (K. R. Barkman Park). Construction and operation of the supplemental supply system is proposed for 2017.
