Manitoba Hydro has filed an Environmental Impact Statement for the Pointe du Bois Spillway Replacement Project. An Environment Act Proposal for the project was filed in June, 2010. The project involves the construction of new spillways and new concrete and earth dams at the Pointe du Bois Generating Station. The existing powerhouse will not be rebuilt, and will continue to operate with ongoing activities to maintain safety and reliability. Historical water level ranges will continue to be maintained on the forebay during and following the construction of the new spillway and dam components. The new spillway and dam facilities will be decommissioned upon the completion of the new facilities. Construction on the project is anticipated to start in 2011, with completion scheduled for 2016.
