## Re: Environment Act Licence No. 3107 – Notice of Alteration: Expansion of Excavated Material Placement Area D23(2)-E

This letter will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated April 13, 2018, regarding the proposed alteration to Environment Act Licence no. 3107 issued to Keeyask Hydropower Limited Partnership for the Keeyask Generation Project.

Your letter requests permission to expand Excavated Material Placement Area (EMPA) D23(2)-E by 5.15 hectares in order to ensure sufficient area to place materials from excavation activities associated with the South Dyke Transition and the South Dam Abutment.
