Could you please provide a response to the following comments generated from the TAC review of the Notice of Alteration for the Lake Winnipeg East System Improvement Transmission Project?

- 1. Will the proponent be employing bird strike mitigation measures along this altered portion of the route? Chapter 6.8 of the *Wildlife Technical Report* outlines that the proponent *may* use bird diverters and aerial markers in high traffic bird areas. Wildlife Branch would like clarification as to whether the proponent considers this site to be a high traffic bird area, and if so what type of bird diversion techniques they plan to employ.
- 2. Can the river crossing be built so that towers are not right adjacent to the river (ideally 30 m from the shoreline)?
