The project would involve the installation of approximately 75 km of distribution pipeline installed in municipal and provincial road rights-of-way. Water for the system would be provided by the Morris Regional Water Treatment Plant. Construction of the water supply system expansion would take place in 2014-2015, subject to the availability of funding.
