It has been brought to our attention via notification within the Winnipeg Free Press Edition of Saturday March 22, 2014, that Future Scrap Div. of Xpotential Products Inc. Auto wrecking – file 5702.00 are considering a new development on Lot 1 Plan 29953 W.L.T.O. within E ¼ 16-11-5 EPM.

This parcel is currently zoned "MG" Industrial General Zoning District under Springfield Zoning By-law No. 08-01, as amended.

Under the current zoning, Auto wrecking falls under "Storage Compound" (definitions stated below) are listed as a Conditional Use.

"Storage Compound means a development used exclusively for temporary outdoor storage of goods and materials where such storage of goods and materials does not involve the erection of permanent structures or the material alteration of the existing state of the land. Typical uses include vehicle storage compounds, automobile wrecking yards, automobile recycling facilities and salvage yards."

To date our office has not received any application nor enquiry for any Storage Compound – Auto Wrecking establishment relating to the subject site and must receive approval of Municipal Council, via the Conditional Use Process.

Hello, I would like to mention some of my concerns with the proposal. I own a business across the street (1020 Redonda). I have also previously resided at 1122 Redonda street for a number of years which is still occupied and is much closer(approx. 100m) then the 900m mentioned. during those years there has been two major fires at Xpotential that have taken days to put out and one that we had to be evacuated from our business and residence. These are major concerns because at their other location on Springfield road there was also a major fire. It also took a number of days to put out because the fire was so large the Rm of Springfield did not have enough fire fighting equipment to put out the blaze and required help from other districts. The location on Springfield road is not presentable and an environmental hazard. We have been told that the ground and water is contaminated at that location due to the lack of containing fluids from vehicles being dismantled and shredded. I greatly feel the proposed facility will be very similar to the existing location on Springfield road and will be very harmful to the environment and surrounding area. My business and most of the others in the area have wells and depend on them for our facilities water.
